Call Permit Hearing to order
Roll call of members present

1. Permit Hearing on the following **Operating & Drilling/Operating Permit Applications:**

- **One (1) new Operating permit for 10786 Vaughn Agricultural, LLC**

Well #4 – (BVOP-0322) Located at: N 31.01202661° W 96.68765600° 1.31 miles ESE of the intersection of FM 2159 and SH-6 in Robertson County. Total maximum annual production from the water well will be 200 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 250 gpm for Agricultural use. The well produces from the Simboro Aquifer.

- **One (1) new Drilling/Operating permit for Clifford A. Skiles III**

Well #2 – (BVDO-0317) Located at: N 30.854431° W 96.628822° 0.86 miles N of the intersection of US-79 W and Gifford Hill Road in Robertson County. Total maximum annual production from the water well will be 2,100 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 1,600 gpm for Agricultural, Industrial, and Public Water Supply uses. Applicant requests the well be aggregated with BVDO-0108 not to exceed 4,800 ac-ft/yr of production from all wells. The well will produce from the Simsboro Aquifer.

- **One (1) new Drilling/Operating permit for Bradley E. Ely et al**

Well #1 – (BVDO-0318) Located at: N 30.844219° W 96.593650° 1.28 miles ESE of the intersection of US-79 W and FM 50 in Robertson County. Total maximum annual production from the water well will be 230 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 800 gpm for Agricultural use. The well will produce from the Brazos River Alluvium Aquifer.

2. Permit Hearing on the following **Operating Permit Amendment Application:**

- **One (1) existing Drilling/Operating permit for Clifford A. Skiles III**

Well #1 – (BVDO-0108) Located at: N 30.851042° W 96.635889° 0.82 miles NNW of the intersection of US-79 W and Gifford Hill Road in Robertson County. Total maximum annual production from the water well is currently 1,400 ac-ft/yr at a maximum rate of 3,000 gpm for Agricultural, Industrial, Public Water Supply uses. Applicant requests amending the current permit increasing the total maximum annual production from the water well to 2,700 ac-ft/yr, decreasing the maximum rate of production to 2,000 gpm,

and aggregating production with BVDO-0317 not to exceed 4,800 ac-ft/yr of production from all wells. The well produces from the Simsboro Aquifer.

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
