The Board of Directors may meet in closed session, pursuant to the Texas Open Meeting Act, Texas Government Code § 551.071-551.076 to:

  2. deliberate regarding the purchase, exchange, lease, or value of real property if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the Corporation in negotiation with a third person; (551.072)
  3. deliberate a negotiated contact for a prospective gift or donation to the Corporation if deliberation in an open meeting would have a detrimental effect on the position of the Corporation in negotiations with a third person; (551.073)
  4. to deliberate the appointment, employment, evaluation, reassignment, duties, discipline, or dismissal of a Board member or Corporation employee; (551.074)
