Disaster Declaration 7-7-24

Hurricane Beryl

WHEREAS, based on current data and information Colorado County is under imminent threat of widespread or severe damage, injury or loss of life, disruption or failure of utility and communications services preceding and following landfall of Hurricane Beryl; and,

WHEREAS, the County Judge of Colorado County has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect, mitigate, and alleviate the suffering of people, provide essential services, and to protect or rehabilitate property resulting from Hurricane Beryl.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF COLORADO COUNTY:

1. That a state of disaster is declared for Colorado County pursuant to §418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
2. That the County's Emergency Management Plan has been implemented.
3. That this state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days of the date hereof, unless the same is continued by consent of the Commissioners Court of Colorado County.
4. Pursuant to §418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Colorado County Clerk and the Texas Division of Emergency Management.
5. Pursuant to §418.108(f) of the Texas Government Code, the County Judge of Colorado County may order the evacuation of all or part of the population from a threatened area if the County Judge considers the action necessary for the preservation of life or other disaster mitigation, response, or recovery.


6. Pursuant to §418.108(g) of the Texas Government Code, the County Judge of Colorado County may control ingress to and egress from a threatened area and control the movement of persons and the occupancy of premises in that area.
7. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
