1.	2015 average appraised value of residence homestead.	\$ 60,299
2.	2015 general exemptions available for the average homestead (excluding age 65 or older or disabled persons exemptions).	-\$ 165
3.	2015 average taxable value of residence homestead (Line 1 minus Line 2).	\$ 60,134
4.	2015 adopted M&O tax rate (per \$100 of value).	\$.092220 /\$100
5.	2015 M&O tax on average residence homestead (Multiply Line 3 by Line 4, divide by \$100).	\$ 55.45
6.	Highest M&O tax on average residence homestead with increase (Multiply Line 5 by 1.08).	\$ 59.88
7.	2016 average appraised value of residence homestead.	\$ 58,022
8.	2016 general exemptions available for the average homestead (Excluding age 65 or older or disabled persons exemptions).	-\$ 133
9.	2016 average taxable value of residence homestead (Line 7 minus Line 8).	\$ 57,889
10.	Highest 2016 M&O Tax Rate (Line 6 divided by Line 9, multiply by \$100)	\$ 103.43 /\$100
11.	2016 Debt Tax Rate.	\$.17505 /\$100
12.	2016 Contract Tax Rate	\$.00000 /\$100
13.	2016 Rollback Tax Rate (add Lines 10, 11 and 12).	\$ 27.848 /\$100

Line	Activity	Amount/Rate
33.	Certified 2015 excess debt collections. Enter the amount certified by the collector.	\$ 0
34.	Adjusted 2016 debt. Subtract Line 33 from Line 32D.	\$ 21,666
35.	Certified 2016 anticipated collection rate. Enter the rate certified by the collector. If the rate is 100 percent or greater, enter 100 percent.	100 %
36.	2016 debt adjusted for collections. Divide Line 34 by Line 35	\$ 21.666
37.	2016 total taxable value. Enter the amount on Line 19.	\$ 12,377.007
38.	2016 debt tax rate. Divide Line 36 by Line 37 and multiply by \$100.	\$ 175.05
