Also, present are Sheriff Joe Salazar, Allan with Raymondville Chronicle, Patty Acevedo with Sheriff's Department, Veteran's Officer Frances Najera, Martha Castillo with Auditor's Office, Constable Deputy Albert Oviedo and Constable Precinct 4 Albert Garza.

Discussion continues on reference to the overtime at the Sheriff's Department and Jail Department.

Commissioner Eliberto Guerra arrives at the meeting at 9:50 a.m.

As per the Chairman, to summarize on reference to the overtime:

1. Sheriff to implement Jailers' Schedules to reduce from 12 hours to 8 hours
2. Schedule a Workshop with Warden Venegas to discuss about the meals
3. Find several options for meals
4. District Attorney's Assistant will check into processing Misdemeanor Cases on defendants in the jail sooner and if possible have an extra docket with weeks notice

Sheriff Salazar, states the he would prefer leasing new vehicles instead of purchasing and recommends the County Jail Kitchen for meals. The Sheriff also will work on a cost estimate to utilize the County Jail Kitchen.
