SPECIAL ELECTION - CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS

Tuesday, November 7, 2023

- VOTER REGISTRATION DEADLINE: Tuesday, October 10, 2023
- LAST DAY TO REQUEST A VOTE BY MAIL: Friday, October 27, 2023
- FIRST DAY OF EARLY VOTING: Monday, October 23, 2023
- LAST DAY TO RECEIVE BALLOT (UNPOSTMARKED) BY MAIL: Wednesday, November 8, 2023
- LAST DAY TO RECEIVE (WITHOUT POSTMARK) FPCA: Monday, November 13, 2023

ENGLISH

Texas allows residents to vote in the days and weeks leading up to an election to make the voting process more convenient and accessible. There are two ways to vote early: by showing up in person during the prescribed early voting period or by voting by mail.

Vote early in Person

Generally, early in-person voting begins on the 17th day before Election Day (if it's a weekend, early voting begins on Monday) and ends on the 4th day before Election Day.

Curbside voting

This service is available to any voter who has difficulty walking or standing for long periods. If you have an aide with you, when you arrive at the polling place, ask them to notify the election official at that time. The voter will still need to provide a voter registration card, if available, the aide must have proper identification to give to the poll worker before voting. The election official will then take your ballot to your car outside the polling place. If you do not have an attendant, call 432-586-3401 ahead of time to notify the election clerk that you want to vote curbside.
