AND WHEREAS, THE MATTER BROUGHT BEFORE THE Court was the setting of a tax rate as required by Article 26.05, Texas Tax Code; and

WHEREAS, after notice and hearing, the following motion was offered by Commissioner and seconded by Commissioner ::

WINKLER COUNTY ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S RATE.

"THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE LOWERED BY 12.49% AND WILL DECREASE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$90.00":

"I move that the 2019 tax rate of 0.50 per \$100.00 valuation of property be adopted. This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate."
