**NOTE TO PRESIDING JUDGE:**

The automatic tabulating equipment may not be used to count ballots voted in the election until the second test conducted under Section 127.093(c) is successful. If the initial second test is unsuccessful, the Presiding Judge of the Central Counting Station shall prepare a written record of the changes to the program, adjustments to the equipment, and other actions taken to achieve a successful second test. The record shall be retained with the test materials. When a test is successful, the Presiding Judge shall certify in writing that a test was successful and the date and hour the test was completed. **NOTE TO PRESIDING JUDGE:**

If the initial third test conducted under Section 127.093(d) is unsuccessful, the count of ballots voted in the election obtained with the automatic tabulating equipment is void.

If the initial third test is successful, the automatic count of ballots voted in the election is valid for the purpose of certifying the election returns prepared at the central counting station. The Presiding Judge shall certify in writing that the initial test was successful and the date and hour the test was completed. The certification shall be retained with the test materials.


If the initial third test was unsuccessful, the testing authorities shall follow the procedure prescribed by Section 127.097. When a test is successful, the ballots to be counted automatically shall immediately be counted. Immediately on completing the automatic count, the equipment shall again be tested, and if the initial test is successful the automatic count is valid for the purpose of certifying the election returns. Otherwise, the automatic ballot count is void. The procedure prescribed by 127.098(c) shall be repeated until a valid automatic count is obtained or the testing authorities determine that obtaining a valid automatic count is impracticable. In that case, the ballots shall be counted manually. [Sec. 127.098]

We certify that:

- The public counter was set to zero at the start of the test and a zero tape was printed from each tabulation device.
- Each contest position, as well as each precinct and ballot style, was able to be voted and was accurately counted.
- Each type of device that will be used to mark or tabulate ballots in the election, including ballot marking devices, precinct scanners, and/or central scanners (whichever is applicable) was included in the testing.
- Each type of ballot that will be used in the election, including voter-marked ballots, ballots by mail, and ballots marked by ballot marking devices, were included in the test.
- The test materials included ballots with overvotes, ballots with undervotes, if applicable to the system being tested, multi-candidate races, provisional votes and write-in votes, if applicable.
- The test ballots were marked and labeled as test ballots.
- The accessibility features on the voting devices were tested by a two-person testing board.
- A representative sample of voting system equipment was tested with a hash validation process to ensure that the source code of the equipment has not been altered.
- The trusted hashes for each unique device in the voting system are pertinent to the most current version of the voting system and were obtained from the Secretary of State's office prior to the Public Logic and Accuracy Test.
- The devices that were tested, and the serial numbers of those devices, are listed on the following pages attached to this certification.
- If any problems occurred in the course of the testing, the cause of those issues, and any resolution taken to address those problems, are included in the documentation that is attached to this certification.
- The expected results of the test were compared to the actual results and it was determined that the test was successful.


