Procedure to Obtain a Rebuilt Title / Resume Operations

for Salvaged Vehicles

Step 1: Complete the enclosed <u>Form VTR-441</u> and send it with the applicable \$8.00 fee (check or money order) along with the original title to TXDMV at the following address:

TEXAS DEPARTMENT OF MOTOR VEHICLE VEHICLE TITLES AND REGISTRATION DIVISION PO BOX 26450 AUSTIN, TX 78755-0450

TXDMV will issue a Salvage Vehicle Title and mail it to the owner or lienholder.

- Step 2: Complete vehicle repairs and keep the receipts for all repair parts and services.
- Step 3: Obtain a new vehicle safety inspection after the repairs are completed and **AFTER** receipt of the Salvage Vehicle Title. Be sure to request an Identification Certificate (form VI-30).
- Step 4: Submit the Salvage Vehicle Title to your County Tax Assessor-Collector's office along with:
 - A properly completed <u>Form 130-U</u>, Application for Texas Certificate of Title
 - A <u>Form VTR-61</u>, *Rebuilt Affidavit,* recording component parts used (and their origin)
 - Vehicle Inspection Report (VIR)
 - Proof of insurance that meets Texas Liability Minimums

Application fee, Registration renewal fees (if applicable), and a \$65.00 Rebuilder Fee will be assessed.

UPON completion of Step 4, the vehicle title will be appropriately branded and the vehicle may again be operated on public roadways.
