CONTINUATION OF DECLARATION OF DISASTER

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Hutchinson County, Texas on this the 4th day of March, 2024, determined that Hutchinson County has been affected by recent wildfires which caused extensive damage to public and private property, disruption of utility service, injury or loss of life, and endangerment of the health and safety of the residents of Hutchinson County, and continues to be threatened by these severe conditions and;

WHEREAS, the Commissioners' Court of Hutchinson County, Texas, has determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to protect life, as well as to protect or rehabilitate property, are necessary and hereby ordered.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE COUNTY JUDGE OF
HUTCHINSON COUNTY:


- I. That a local state of disaster was declared by the County Judge for Hutchinson County, Texas on February 27, 2024 pursuant to Section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- II. Pursuant to Section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than 30 days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Commissioners' Court of Hutchinson County, Texas.
- III. Pursuant to Section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the County Clerk.
- IV. Pursuant to Section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the county/city Emergency Management Plan.






