

2. Approval of repairing roof on building next to Appraisal district office

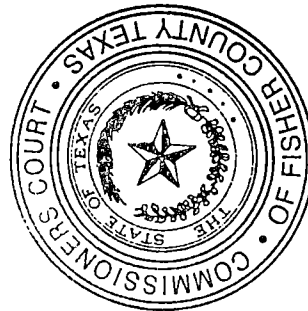


Came now on June 19, 2017 before Commissioners Court:

To the extent the Fisher County Commissioners' Court can do so, if at all, Fisher County Commissioners' Court approves of the closure of:



To Whom it May Concern:

We request the closure of the following undeveloped rights-of-way, located in Sylvester, Texas. It is proposed that the ownership be given back to the adjoining land owner, to the center-line of the portion of the right-of-way they adjoin.
