THE COUNTY COURTS AT LAW OF ECTOR COUNTY, TEXAS DRESSCODE

AT ALL FUTURE DOCKET CALLS, HEARINGS, AND TRIAL DATES, THE FOLLOWING DRESS CODE SHALL BE OBSERVED:

THE ECTOR COUNTY COURTS AT LAW WILL OBSERVE THE FOLLOWING DRESS CODE, WHICH APPLIES TO <u>ALL</u> PERSONS WHO ARE REQUIRED TO ENTER THE COURTROOM, FOR ANY AND ALL CIVIL AND CRIMINAL MATTERS:

MEN ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR: LONG PANTS, A COLLARED SHIRT (must be tucked in), SHOES AND SOCKS. (The use of a tie and /or suit jacket are optional).

WOMEN ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR: SHOES (flip flops are not permitted) AND ANY OF THE FOLLOWING: A DRESS, PANTS OR A SKIRT WITH A BLOUSE OR CASUAL DRESS SHIRT.

THE FOLLOWING TYPES OF CLOTHING ARE <u>NOT PERMITTED</u>, AND IF WORN WILL BE GROUNDS FOR REFUSING ADMITTANCE TO, OR REMOVAL FROM, THE COURTROOM:

Hats (applies to both men and women)
Flip flops (applies to both men and women)
Halter tops/tube tops
T-shirts/muscle shirts

See-Through tops

Shorts

Ripped jeans

Baggy pants that fall below your waist and expose underwear

Clothing that exposes midriff

Pajamas/sweat pants

Clothing that depicts or promotes violence, sex acts, drug use, illegal or inappropriate activity or profanity

REMOVAL FROM THE COURTROOM, OR BEING REFUSED ADMITTANCE, MAY RESULT IN A WARRANT BEING ISSUED FOR FAILURE TO APPEAR AT YOUR HEARING (in a criminal matter) OR A DEFAULT JUDGMENT BEING ENTERED AGAINST YOU (in a civil matter).

ALL DECISIONS ON THE APPROPRIATENESS OF ATTIRE WILL BE MADE BY COURT PERSONNEL.
