

SECTION 2: The boundaries of the proposed District shall be all portions of the territory of Ector County, Texas excluding all territory within the municipal limits of the Cities of Odessa and Goldsmith.

SECTION 3: In accordance with the provisions of an election services contract (the "Contract") with the Ector County Elections Administrator, the location, dates and times for early voting for this election shall be as shown in **Exhibit A**, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part hereof for all purposes. Lisa Sertuche, Ector County Elections Administrator, is hereby appointed early voting clerk and shall appoint and designate deputy clerks for early voting in accordance with the Contract.

For purposes of processing ballots cast in early voting, the election officers for the early voting ballot board for this election shall be appointed and designated in accordance with the provisions of the Contract.

SECTION 4: The Election Day Vote Centers are as shown in **Exhibit B** attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference as a part hereof for all purposes. The election officers for each Vote Center and the maximum number of clerks shall be determined and appointed in accordance with the Contract.

For purposes of processing ballots cast in early voting, the election officers for the early voting ballot board for this election shall be appointed and designated in accordance with the provisions of the Contract.

On election day, the polls shall be open from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

SECTION 5: A voting system or systems meeting the standards and requirements of the Texas Election Code, as amended, is hereby adopted and approved for early voting by personal appearance and by mail and for election day voting.

Ballots shall be prepared in accordance with the Texas Election Code, and permit electors to vote "FOR" or "AGAINST" the aforesaid measure which shall appear on the ballot substantially as follows:

ECTOR COUNTY ASSISTANCE DISTRICT PROPOSITION A

"AUTHORIZING THE CREATION OF THE ECTOR COUNTY ASSISTANCE DISTRICT AND THE IMPOSITION OF A SALES AND USE TAX AT THE RATE OF 1.25 PERCENT FOR THE PURPOSE OF FINANCING THE OPERATIONS OF THE DISTRICT"

SECTION 6: The Central Counting Station for the tabulation and counting of ballots for this election shall be located at the Ector County Elections Office, 1010 East Eighth Street, Odessa, Texas, and the persons to serve as Manager, Tabulation Supervisor, Presiding Judge and Alternate Presiding Judge at the Central Counting Station shall be appointed in accordance with the Contract. The Manager and Presiding Judge of the Central Counting Station may appoint clerks to serve at such Station, as provided by Section 127.006 of the Election Code.

SECTION 7: All resident qualified electors within the boundaries of the proposed district shall be permitted to vote at said election. This election shall be held and conducted in

accordance with the provisions of the Texas Election Code and the Act, and as may be required by law, all election materials and proceedings shall be printed in both English and Spanish.

SECTION 8: A substantial copy of this Order shall serve as proper notice of said election. Said notice shall be published at least one time not more than thirty (30) days or less than ten (10) days before the day of the election in a newspaper of general circulation in the County. Additionally, the notice shall be posted (i) on the bulletin board used for posting notices of the Commissioners Court meetings.

SECTION 9: The County Judge, County Clerk, County Auditor or other appropriate official, is hereby authorized to correct, modify or change the information herein based upon the final locations and times agreed upon by and between the Ector County Elections Administrator and the County Judge. Additionally, the County Judge and other County officials are hereby authorized to sign this Order and all other documents associated with the election.
