244th District Court Dress Code

All persons entering this Courtroom shall be dressed appropriately.

No sleeveless shirts, shorts, or excessively baggy pants will be allowed in the Courtroom. Men must have shirt tails tucked into their trousers.

No sunglasses, hats of any kind, or flip-flop shoes will be worn in the Courtroom.

No clothing with pictures; vulgar, racist, sexist, obscene, or suggestive words, or other depictions that will distract the proceeding will be allowed in the Courtroom.

Counsel shall so instruct clients, witnesses and other persons accompanying them into the Courtroom.

Final approval of appropriate dress will be determined by Court personnel.
