Commissioner Rodriguez asked if they could show the boundaries and population numbers by moving certain voting precincts that would include a portion of I-20 within Precinct 3 boundaries. After redrawing the precincts Mr. Mendez stated that they could not get the population numbers where they needed to be making the suggested moves. They discussed having a public meeting on October 21, 2021.
