Call to Order:

2. Concerns/To Do List Items

Work Orders- 01/02/24 Water heater at the N end lavatory has stopped working. 01/03/24 Runway 1-6 PAPI lights are out. 01/04/24 Runway lights are out on 11-29 are out. 01/23/24 Overflow is leaking from the hangar onto the hangar below.

A. Water Project Presentation- Want to lease land from airport to make well based for oil and water rigs. 30/40 wells 1 per 20 acres. Main concern is water issues for people surround the airport, do not want to dry out water for airport or surround areas. It would be a 5-year term and start 90 days after 2024 if approved, if not approved they will look at other areas to start project.

B. Amend Texas Aero bank agreement- Aero wants to use the terminal building as collateral to allow bank to cure and take care of the leases, will recommend to commissioner's court.

- C. Runway/Taxiway Lights- 20 PAPI lights are working.
- D. Devore PLASI 2000- PVASI lights are still on back order.
- E. Engineering on installation- Engineer is working on first survey.
- F. Pavement Repairs- Keep on ordering materials, 2 pallets monthly.
- G. Core Testing- is in progress.

H. Water Tower Construction- Water tower is being built with no issues, no issues with airport as well.

I. Update on oil wells- FAA approved, now waiting on Landgraf to move pad north. Also needing to setup conference call.

3. Safety Issues

A. JSX Charter is no longer coming.

B. Hangar Entry and inspections- A few incidents occurred; all tenant's need a 48-hour notice prior to entering their hangar.

4. Vegetation Management

Process is done.

5. GRANTS

ARPA grant- we are waiting for cleared checks of past payment history from the bank, once received we will start the process to send all information to receive the 148,000.00 from TXDOT.

6. FBO Report

Jet sales are down low lead is down. We have 20 medium hangars, and 3 small on the south end.
