- 4. Discussion with Janelle Berry about closing the libraries. Discussion about curbside or foyer delivery. Larry McCauley made a motion to close the libraries with only staff there. Motion seconded by Frank Mullins and carried by unanimous vote of the court.
- 5. Debra Riley- sick leave waiver is mandated to allow up to 80 hours of sick leave for full time employees if they are quarantined or caring for a child in quarantine. This will not have anything to do with employees' regular sick leave. Motion made by Donald Kirksey, seconded by Frank Mullins to accept the mandated sick leave waiver. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the court.
- 6. Motion made by Larry McCauley, seconded by Frank Mullins to amend the Declaration of Disaster from a group of 50 people to a group of 10 people. Motion carried by unanimous vote of the Court.
