



## Mass Gathering Permits

As of May 2023, Mass Gathering inspections for permits will be required to be updated bi-annually. The first inspection will be due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of February preceding the event. And the Second inspection will be due by the 1<sup>st</sup> of July preceding the event. All paperwork, certificates, and licenses will need to be updated at the same previously specified time. If all items here listed are not received, then the County Judge does hold the right to post-pone or reject all permits for the intended mass gathering.

The inspections that must be completed are a Fire-Marshal Inspection, a Health and Safety Inspection, and a Sheriff's Department Inspection. There will be a \$250.00 Fire-Marshal Inspection Fee and a \$250.00 Health and Safety Inspection Fee that is due when the paper work is filed Bi-Annually at the Bailey County Judge's office for the Mass gathering. These fees do not include the filing fee of \$500 that is due upon each request to hold a mass gathering.

Bi-annually a full Mass Gathering application will be required to be completed and submitted to the Judge's office on or before the dates of February 1<sup>st</sup> and July 1<sup>st</sup>.
