

Bailey County and the City of Muleshoe continue to Monitor the Covid 19 virus, commonly called the Coronavirus. As of May 7, 2020, there have still only been the two positive cases, out of approximately 75 tests administered in Bailey County. Results are still pending on 4 of those tests.

Regarding the recent positive cases at Track Dairy: On May 4th a team of nurses from the Texas Department of State Health Services (“DSHS”) went to Track Dairy to test all of the remaining dairy employees who were exposed to those workers who tested positive. Today, we received word that all of those tests were negative. We would like to thank Track Dairy’s owners, management, and employees for cooperating and working with state and local officials to do everything possible to protect not only their employees, but also the public in general. Track Dairy voluntarily isolated all employees who could have been exposed; Additionally, they limited all access into and out of the dairy to a select few, who had no contact with the employees isolated there. Because of these actions and at the recommendation of DSHS, Track Dairy will resume full operations beginning tomorrow May 8, 2020.

The three employees who tested positive, 2 of which were Bailey County Residents, remain quarantined.
