Accordingly, the entity is seeking assistance with the grant application and to contract with a qualified Engineering Firm to provide engineering services for this project if grant funding is awarded.

The entity reserves the right to negotiate with any and all firms submitting proposals, in accordance with 40 CFR 31.36.

Contract for Engineering Services is contingent upon release of funds from the TWDB. Any contract awarded under this Request for Qualifications (RFQ) is expected to be funded by funds from the TWDB. Neither the State of Texas nor any of it departments, agencies, or employees are or will be a party to this RFQ, or any resulting contract.

Contract is subject to the Environmental Protection Agency's (EPA) "fair share policy", which includes EPA-approved "fair share goals" for Minority Business Enterprise (MBE) & Women Business Enterprise (WBE) firms in the Construction, Supplies, Equipment and Services procurement categories. EPA's policy requires that applicants and prime contractors made a good faith effort to award a fair share of contracts, subcontracts, and procurements to Minority Business Enterprise and Women-Owned Business Enterprise Firms. Although EPA's policy does not mandate that the fair share goals be achieved, it does require applicants and prime contractors to demonstrate use of the six affirmative steps.
