LIVESTOCK REGISTRATION FORM

Completing this form will enable Fannin County Deputies and dispatchers to notify owners of stray livestock without resorting to impounding animals or transporting them. The Sheriff's Office will attempt to reunite stray livestock with owners promptly and efficiently. Registering livestock reduces injury to the animals, and damage to fencing and property for which livestock owners may be liable. When our dispatchers receive a call concerning loose livestock, the dispatcher will compare the description given with all livestock registered in that area. If a match is discovered, the owner will be notified. This system reduces costs and prevents the damage or injury that may occur with livestock transport.
