

**MINUTES OF COMMISSIONER COURT, MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS
REGULAR SESSION, MONDAY, JULY 13, 2026**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 13th DAY OF JULY, 2026 there came to be held a Regular Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to-wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1, Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Brenda McKanna, Moore County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Commissioner Vaughan was absent from the meeting.

During routine announcements and reports Coy stated they won't have numbers on the rolling stock until July 25th and with the next meeting being on July 27th there will not be enough time to get the numbers ready for the meeting. Coy stated he would like to input last year's numbers so the court can move forward with the budget process. Coy discussed with the court regarding Ballard Plumbing invoicing the county and asked at what point they don't pay until the plumbing job is completed. Commissioner Garcia will visit with B.J. Ballard to see if he can get a completion timeline.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of June 22, 2026 and Special Called Meeting of June 29, 2026. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Commissioner Mixon "Abstained" from June 22, 2026.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon that the bills as presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the Temporary Cash and Investments dated July 13, 2026 as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date, be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the 2026 assessment and collections contracts for Amarillo College, City of Cactus and Sunray ISD. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried. Copy of contracts attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the purchase of a computer for the tax office in the amount of \$2,022.98. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve a T-Hangar Rental Lease Agreement between Dustin Dinh and Moore County Airport effective August 1, 2026. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of agreement attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Sheriff's Office to purchase electronic storage equipment and forensic/preservation equipment in the amount of \$14,573.99 to be paid out of the JAG Grant as approved in the budget. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the proposal from Revolution Data Systems in the amount of \$34,967.68 for the preservation and digitization of Election Minutes Books 1, 1-A-5 and Marks & Brands books 1-7 with expenditure to be paid from the County Clerk Records Archive Fund. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of quote attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the County Clerk to move forward with the request to create County Wide Vote Centers and submit the application and documentation as presented to the Secretary of State for the County Wide Vote Centers. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of proposal attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve AI training Course Enrollment with TAC as required by Texas Gov. Code 2054.519 at no cost to the county. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the Certified County Road Inventory for TxDot with no changes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of certification attached and made a part hereof by references.

Randy Kelso, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave an update on the department. Randy stated they have worked on Road 28, Road I and installed a culvert on Road 22. They have mowed most of the paved roads in Moore County; he also got a map of all the cattle guards on county roads. The new pickup will be delivered tomorrow, and the pickup will be assigned specifically to Frank. Next week they will be helping the City of Dumas with their seal coat project and then move on to helping City of Cactus and City of Sunray. He reported that Ballard Plumbing told him it would be another three weeks before the parking lot paving could be done. Randy reported on the truck repair issue and stated it is still not repaired but they are requesting payment of \$5,900.00 and he reported that Scott told him they would have to pay the invoice even though the truck is not fixed. Scott did say the company could come before the court and explain why the truck is not fixed and why the county should have to pay for the repairs even though the truck is not fixed.

Randy reported Chandler Preston will be giving the county some free material from an area that he is going to be developing a caliche pit. Commissioner Garcia asked about spraying weeds on the roads and Randy stated Mark has been spraying off and on. Commissioner Garcia asked him to spray at the end of Schuman Road & Road E and repair a pothole on Road I.

It appears there is no other business to come before the court. Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.
