

**MINUTES OF COMMISSIONERS COURT, MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS
SPECIAL SESSION, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 23, 2026**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 23RD DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2026 there came to be held a Special Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioner's Courtroom of the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to wit: Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1; Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Brenda McKanna, County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Judge Rowdy Rhoades was absent from the meeting.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the minutes of the Special Meeting of January 26, 2026 and the Regular Meeting of February 9, 2026. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried. Commissioner Vaughan "Abstained" from the meeting on January 26, 2026.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan that the bills presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

There were two bills presented for special handling:

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the payment in the amount of \$9,353.77 to Ballard Plumbing with expenditure to be paid out of the SCAAP Grant. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the payment in the amount of \$43,000.00 to Doshier, Frances & Pickens for the out of county audit. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the Temporary Cash and Investments dated February 23, 2026 as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date, be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon Motion carried

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to renew the annual participation in the Moore County News-Press Visitor Guide with the full-page ad at a cost of \$465.00. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of agreement attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to keep the 2026 homestead exemption for Moore County at the current exemption. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to keep the 2026 homestead exemption for Amarillo College at the current exemption. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.


Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the payment of \$6.77 to Cactus and Dumas with expenditure to be paid out of the county's portion of the FEMA payment. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.



Randy Kelso, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave an update on the department. Randy stated he would like to purchase an outhouse to be placed at the caliche pit and let the one that the county is being charged for go back, he will budget for one in the future budget. The state told him he might be able to get some of the RAP that is stockpiled around the Etter area. Commissioner Vaughan asked Randy to do an analysis of opening a second caliche pit closer to the Dumas area. Randy created a preventive maintenance schedule that drivers will be required to perform on their equipment. Randy stated he would like to sell the poly patch machine since no one knows how to use the machine and does not have any type of training on the machine


It appears there is no other business to come before the court. Motion was made by Commissioner to Farni to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.
