

**MINUTES OF COMMISSIONER COURT, MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS
REGULAR SESSION, MONDAY, FEBRUARY 9, 2026**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 9TH DAY OF FEBRUARY, 2026 there came to be held a Regular Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to-wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1, Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Dee Vaughan, Commissioner Precinct 3; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Cindy Sullivan, Deputy County Clerk.

Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni that the bills as presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

There were three bills presented for special handling:
Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve the payment in the amount of \$21,380.69 to Potter County Indigent Defense Grant. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the payment in the amount of \$1,000.00 to Lori Hayhurst for a plow disc for the Road & Bridge Department. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the payment of \$500.00 to Glass Tech for the balance owed for doors at the Extension office with expenditure to be paid out of Repairs & Maintenance. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the Temporary Cash and Investments dated February 9, 2026 as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date, be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Vaughan to approve up to six loads of caliche to assist Talon Point which is a 501c3 nonprofit. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to donate 1.8 acres of land being Lots 1,2,3,4,5 and 6 Block 12 South Addition Sunray from Moore County to the City of Sunray for the

Sunray Fire Department. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Vaughan. Motion carried. Copy of deed attached and made a part hereof by references.

Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve steel doors with glass for the Extension office in the amount of \$2,835.00. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to take "No Action" regarding the adoption of an order authorizing the sale of fireworks for Texas Independence Day. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the purchase of axles for a truck in the amount of \$4,500.00 to be paid out of Road & Bridge Maintenance & Repairs budget. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

Randy Kelso, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave an update on the department. Randy stated he visited with Miguel Carillo, a landowner, on Road 24 and Miguel thought the road was a private road. Miguel has some more land on Road 26, and he wants to build a drainage pond, he stated the county could take all the material out of there until they reach the size for his pond. Randy stated the caliche from the land is a rose color instead of white. Miguel will let the county have whatever they want if they start on Road 24 first. Randy stated it is a better option than dirt and they could use it on roads that are close to the location. He had some adjustments done to the crusher which he says will produce much better material. He stated everyone is going to attend a safety class for grading and underground utilities. He stated he had two phone calls for the apprentice position which he hasn't listed yet. He will list the position and run it for about a month, and he would like to set a probation period.





Commissioner Precinct 1, J. Daniel Garcia




Commissioner Precinct 2, Miles Mixon




Commissioner Precinct 3, Dee Vaughan
