

**MINUTES OF COMMISSIONER COURT, MOORE COUNTY, TEXAS  
REGULAR SESSION, MONDAY, MAY 11, 2026**

BE IT REMEMBERED THAT ON THIS 11<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF MAY, 2026 there came to be held a Regular Session of Commissioners Court of Moore County, Texas in the Commissioners Courtroom in the Courthouse in Dumas, Texas. The following persons were present to-wit: Rowdy Rhoades, County Judge; Daniel Garcia, Commissioner Precinct 1, Miles Mixon, Commissioner Precinct 2; Colt Farni, Commissioner Precinct 4 and Brenda McKanna, Moore County Clerk.

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Court having been opened according to law the following proceedings were had to wit:

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Commissioner Vaughan was absent from the meeting.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni that the bills as presented by County Auditor, Coy Barton, be approved for payment and the County Treasurer is hereby directed to issue warrant-checks thereof. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the Temporary Cash and Investments dated May 11, 2026 as presented by Coy Barton, County Auditor and the County Treasurer's Report of Cash Disbursements of the same date, be approved and duly recorded in the Commissioner's Court Minutes. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve a one-time variance to the subdivision rules for Lot 6 Block 3 Blue Mesa Development Unit 1 and this does not supersede the acceptance of the road located in Blue Mesa which may or may not be accepted in the future. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried. Copy of map attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the expenditures for the Rodeo Association upon approval of the invoices up to \$10,000.00 that was approved in the current budget. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve the 2026 assessment and collections contracts as presented by Chris Rivera, Tax Assessor Collector. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried. Copy of contracts attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve an updated contract with Avco Patrol LLC as presented. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried. Copy of contract attached and made a part hereof by references.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to approve accepting another \$10,000.00 grant from Skyland Grain to go towards the command trailer and awarding \$5,000.00 to Sunray Fire Department. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the purchase of a drone in the amount of \$1,289.00 for Emergency Management Department. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Mixon to approve the 1<sup>st</sup> payment of \$250,000.00 to Leasing Specialists LLC for the Lenco Armored Bearcat and research to see when the SB22 Funds will be allocated to Moore County and make final payment of \$101,410.49 when funds are received and whatever funds are left from SB22 will be applied to balance. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the transmission repair on the water truck in the amount of \$7,100.00. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

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Randy Kelso, Road & Bridge Supervisor gave an update on the department. Randy stated they are continuing to work on Road 24, he has received some complaints regarding Keith Road, he will begin work on Keith Road next; they need to finish the patch at the Kilgore Library. In Sunray they will start working on Cemetery Road and start mowing next week. Randy stated that Jovan Torres would like to start today instead of tomorrow and the court stated that would be okay. Randy stated that when someone is developing a plat, they are not presenting a grading plan and, in the future, he would like that to be a requirement in the subdivision rules.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to approve the purchase of a truck for the Road & Bridge Dept. up to \$26,000.00 that was reimbursed by the insurance and if not investigate the cost of a rental. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.

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At 10:13 A.M. motion was made by Commissioner Garcia that the court enter in Executive Session according to Govt. Code Sec. 551.074 to discuss personnel matters regarding Road & Bridge personnel. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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At 10:36 A.M. motion was made by Commissioner Mixon that the court reconvene in open court. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Farni. Motion carried.

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Motion was made by Commissioner Farni to take "No Action" regarding Road & Bridge personnel. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Garcia. Motion carried.

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It appears there is no other business to come before the court. Motion was made by Commissioner Garcia to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Mixon. Motion carried.
