Honorable Judge Eric Ramos did mention that we had a total of 20 active cases with COVID and that we have well over 30% percent that have received at least on vaccine and a total of 13-15 % that are fulling vaccinated.

Joshua Baez, Landfill employee addressed his concerns on the trash truck, and explained the work needing to be done to the truck. Mrs. Allen stated she received some quotes and one was from Rush Refuse System and would lease a vehicle from 6 to 12 months in the amount of \$5,200.00. Judge Ramos stated that the County will be receiving monies and should consider in purchasing a trash truck. It was discussed that if a trash truck is rented, could it be just for 2 months. It was discussed to get the truck fully inspected and get an estimate on the work needed.
