OPEN MEETING-Honorable Judge Eric Ramos opened the meeting at 6:25 PM

ROLL CALL- Judge Eric Ramos called for roll call:

Honorable Judge Eric Ramos called for recess at 6:26 PM to wait for the other present entities to have a quorum.

<u>PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE-</u> was led by BCISD Board Members and was held before we can open back from recess.

2. <u>Moment of Silence-</u> BCISD Board called for a Moment of Silence; was held before meeting could be reopened.

At 6:32 PM the Court came back into open session; Present: same as before.

3. <u>Presentation of the five (5) community projects selected at the Collaborative Planning</u>
Session held on March 29, 2021.

Honorable Judge Eric Ramos did a presentation on the above matter and discussed the following:

Judge Ramos stated that the budget for this community project would be between \$250,000.00
 -\$500,000.00;

- David Carbajal, VFW Commander addressed the Court on the above matter with a quick presentation on the need of the improvements needed at the VFW Hall, totaling about \$250,000.00;
- Ruben Ramirez, EMC/Fire Chief addressed the Court on the above matter in reference to the Communication tower estimation and the need of the tower totaling under \$1,400,000.00 (it was mentioned that Congressman Gonzalez stated that if this tower would benefit the surrounding counties that he would allow an increase of this project to 1 Million);
- Judge Ramos, Dr. Casas, Superintendent, and Ann Awalt, CACOST addressed the Court in reference to the School Based Health Center and that it will cost about \$1,260,000.00;
- Judge Ramos addressed the Court on the first responder equipment, also Ruben Ramirez, EMC/Fire Chief addressed the Court on the above matter with a total amount \$267,870.08 plus \$55,000.00 for the Sheriff
- It would take about \$250,000.00 to \$300,000.00 for the parks/sport complex (Judge Ramos and Board Member Jordan Garcia addressed the Court on this project)
