

**EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENT
AND GOLF COURSE PRO SHOP LEASE**

THE STATE OF TEXAS
COUNTY OF WINKLER

Pursuant to article 262.0241 of the Texas Local Government Code, this Agreement entered into this 20th day of December, 2019, by and between Winkler County, Texas, operating through its Commissioners' Court, hereinafter referred to as "County", and John Leavitt, hereinafter referred to as "Superintendent/Greenskeeper".

WHEREAS, the County desires to engage the services of Superintendent/Greenskeeper to perform certain duties at the Winkler County Golf Course, and

WHEREAS, Superintendent/Greenskeeper desires to assume said duties at the Golf Course;

I

THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed as follows:

1.1 It is agreed and understood by the Superintendent/Greenskeeper, (S/G) that his first and foremost responsibility and duty shall be the maintenance and operation of the Golf Course at a salary of \$64,169.20 yearly, beginning January 1, 2020 as the Golf Course S/G, plus longevity and any salary increases approved by the Commissioner's Court. *NOTE: This year will have an extra pay period which is reflected in the total. Next year's contract will reflect court approved salary schedule.

1.2 S/G is an employee of the County and subject to all provisions of the Employee Manual as now exists or hereinafter changed.

- 2.2 S/G shall operate a Golf Pro Shop business at the Golf Course in the East (front) portion of an existing metal building now furnished for that purpose, and a reasonable use of the Repair Shop. S/G shall cause the Golf Pro Shop to be open at all reasonable hours from Tuesday through Sunday of each week, except during inclement weather when golf play is not practicable. S/G may operate a golf driving range at the Golf Course, and the expense and proceeds of the golf driving range operations shall be that of S/G.
- 2.3 S/G at his own cost, shall stock and sell the usual merchandise of a Golf Pro Shop, sell food and beverages (non-alcoholic beverages), provide golf carts for rent (only to persons with a valid driver's license), sell golf carts, golf cart parts, repair private golf carts, teach golf lessons, and all of the expenses and proceeds shall be that of the S/G.
- 2.4 S/G shall maintain a good credit rating with all vendors in regard to the Golf Pro Shop business in order to protect the reputation of the Golf Course.
- 2.5 S/G shall keep adequate books and records, prepare and file all tax returns, and timely pay all taxes required in connection with his business. Such books and records shall be the private property of S/G, however, available for review by County.
- 2.6 S/G may use the North part of the long shed for storage of his golf carts and other accessories.
- 2.7 County shall approve all golf tournaments as to sponsors, dates and determine charge to the County for all golf tournaments, including any golf tournament(s) initiated by S/G.
- 2.8 All golf tournaments shall be supervised by S/G and he shall be allowed to award gift certificates in exchange for money paid by the sponsor of golf tournaments, or receive a percentage of the entry fees paid by the players, or a payment amount agreed to by S/G and sponsor. S/G shall be considered the sponsor for all tournaments initiated by

1.3 With approval of the County, S/G shall himself work, hire (with approval of County) and supervise employee(s) to maintain and operate as a first class County Golf Course; purchase supplies, equipment, tools, chemicals and other necessary items for use on the Golf Course; keep all tools and machinery in good working order and repair within the limitations of the budget provided and approval by County; and once each month report to the County on the condition of the Golf Course. If an emergency arises for any expenditure not budgeted, S/G shall request permission of the County for such expenditure.

1.4 S/G shall require all golf players to register at the Pro Shop prior to play, pay green fees and other fees required by the County at the Golf Course, transfer all monies and cash with a list of all players to the County Treasurer weekly.

1.5 S/G shall regulate golf play on the Golf Course and strictly enforce all rules and regulations promulgated by the County regarding the Golf Course and shall report any recurring violations to the County for action.

1.6 S/G shall be allowed to close the Golf Course for any emergency reason or for weather conditions that may result in damage to the Golf Course.

1.7 S/G shall be permitted to attend seminars regarding golf course maintenance with approval of the County.

Separate and apart from the duties and compensation as the S/G of the Golf Course, and not during regular working hours, S/G and County agree that for and in consideration of County permitting S/G the use of the Pro Shop area, cart storage area, permitting S/G to operate a pro shop business and conduct golf tournaments, the parties agree as follows:

2.1 S/G shall continue after five o'clock p.m. the obligations in Paragraphs 1.4 and 1.5 above.

S/G. All tournament sponsors shall be EXPRESSLY approved by County. S/G shall not receive administration fees of more than \$1,500.00 for any two or more days tournament, and no more than \$480.00 for any one day tournament.

2.9 Any golf tournament, sponsored by any organization or private persons, for which no charge is paid to County (with approval by County) shall not be exclusive to the golf tournament members, and shall be open to the public as well as the golf tournament players on an equal tee time basis, e.g. every other tee time for tournament and non tournament players.

2.10 County will not permit any golf cart on the golf course, except those owned by residents of Winkler County, or by approval by County, and operated by such owner, spouse or child with a valid driver's license, between the ages of 15 and 21 years, provided the child's permanent residence is in Winkler County. County may permit non residents to operate private golf carts during a golf tournament with approval by S/G.

2.11 County agrees to keep the Pro Shop in good repair, provide heating, cooling, electricity, water, telephone (not toll calls) and ice machine (for Golf Course purposes).

- 2.12 County shall never be obligated to provide any insurance for property of S/G.
- 2.13 S/G shall hold County harmless from acts and/or omissions of any claim of other parties, shall provide his own property insurance, and County shall never be responsible for any of S/G's property or his acts and/or omissions toward other persons.

This agreement shall terminate upon the anniversary date, unless terminated sooner by mutual agreement or as follows:

1. S/G resigns or is discharged as a county employee, dies or becomes disabled from performing the normal duties hereunder;
2. Upon the violation of any obligation by S/G of any obligations under Paragraph II, County shall have the option to terminate this agreement;
3. Failure of County to exercise an option to terminate shall not be a waiver of a subsequent violation; and
4. Either party may terminate this Agreement upon 30 days written notice.

Upon termination of this Agreement S/G is permitted to remove any personal property or inventory owned by S/G from the Golf Course and do so immediately, which removal shall not damage the County's property.

INMATE AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into effective January 1, 2020 between Winkler County, Texas, and the City of Wink, Texas, upon the following terms and conditions:

VI

City of Wink shall be responsible to deliver and pick up City of Wink prisoners at the Winkler County Law Enforcement City Center.

VII

City of Wink agrees to pay Winkler County to confine a City of Wink prisoner at the rate of \$62.00 per day per prisoner, a day being any part of any day before midnight of the same day. City of Wink agrees to pay Winkler County for City of Wink prisoner confinement and any medical expenses paid by Winkler County upon receiving a written statement for such confinement and/or medical treatment within one (1) month of receipt of statement from City of Wink current available funds.

VIII

City of Wink agrees to hold harmless Winkler County from any and all claims against Winkler County, with the specific exception of any claims arising out of the willful or criminal conduct of any county employee, by reason of the housing, restraining, furnishing meals and bed, other support, medical treatment and/or the lack of any thereof and the release of any City of Wink prisoner.

IX

This contract shall be for a term of one (1) year ending December 31, 2020 unless cancelled in writing by either party upon sixty (60) days written notice to the other party.

Signed effective the date first above written.

Winkler County will release any City of Wink prisoner upon order by the Municipal Court, other Court of competent jurisdiction or written direction of a City of Wink Peace Officer. Any City of Wink prisoner, who in the judgement of the Sheriff or his designee, is a danger to himself or may require regular medication, may be released by Winkler County for medical treatment or to a responsible adult person upon written acknowledgement to be responsible for the City of Wink prisoner.

II

City of Wink may process any City of Wink prisoner through its identification procedure, if it desires, prior to presenting any prisoner to Winkler County, and Winkler County will book, fingerprint, and photograph all City of Wink prisoners at the Winkler County facility. Personal property of any City of Wink prisoner may be inventoried and kept by City of Wink or Winkler County, and the entity in possession of the property shall be responsible therefore.

III

Winkler County will release any City of Wink prisoner upon order by the Municipal Court, other Court of competent jurisdiction or written direction of a City of Wink Peace Officer. Any City of Wink prisoner, who in the judgement of the Sheriff or his designee, is a danger to himself or may require regular medication, may be released by Winkler County for medical treatment or to a responsible adult person upon written acknowledgement to be responsible for the City of Wink prisoner.

IV

Winkler County may present any City of Wink prisoner to any Judge of competent jurisdiction for determination if the City of Wink prisoner shall remain in custody.

V

Winkler County shall notify City of Wink when a City of Wink prisoner requires medical treatment and City of Wink shall immediately take the City of Wink prisoner for medical treatment; however, Winkler County may seek medical treatment for a City of Wink prisoner at any time. City of Wink agrees to pay for or reimburse Winkler County for all medical treatment and hospitalization of any City of Wink prisoner is injured or sick before or after entry into the Winkler County facility.

INMATE AGREEMENT

This agreement is entered into effective January 1, 2020 between Winkler County, Texas, and Loving County, upon the following terms and conditions:

I

Winkler County and Loving County agree that Winkler County will house, furnish meals, support and confine (collectively herein referred to as confine) in the Winkler County Law Enforcement Center, any person (except juveniles) arrested by Loving County and charged by complaint with an offense within the jurisdiction of Loving County. Such person is classified as a Loving County prisoner.

II

Loving County may process any Loving County prisoner through its identification procedure, if it desires, prior to presenting any prisoner to Winkler County, and Winkler County will book, fingerprint, and photograph all Loving County prisoners at the Winkler County facility. Personal property of any Loving County prisoner may be inventoried and kept by Loving County or Winkler County, and the entity in possession of the property shall be responsible therefor.

III

Winkler County will release any Loving County prisoner upon order by the Municipal Court, other Court of competent jurisdiction or written direction of a Loving County Deputy. Any Loving County prisoner, who in the judgment of the Sheriff or his designee, is a danger to himself or may require regular medication, may be released by Winkler County for medical treatment or to a responsible adult person upon written acknowledgement to be responsible for the Loving County prisoner.

IV

Winkler County may present any Loving County prisoner to any judge of competent jurisdiction for determination if the Loving County prisoner shall remain in custody.

V

Winkler County shall notify Loving County when a Loving County prisoner requires medical treatment and Loving County shall immediately take the Loving County prisoner for medical treatment; however, Winkler County may seek medical treatment for a Loving County prisoner at any time. Loving County agrees to pay for or reimburse Winkler County for all medical treatment and hospitalization of any Loving County prisoner whether the Loving County prisoner is injured or sick before or after entry into the Winkler County facility.

VI

Loving County shall be responsible to deliver and pick up Loving County prisoners at the Winkler County Law Enforcement Center.

VII

Loving County agrees to pay Winkler County to confine a Loving County prisoner at the rate of \$62.00 per prisoner, a day being any part of any day before midnight of the same day. Loving County agrees to pay Winkler County for Loving County prisoner confinement and any medical expenses paid by Winkler County upon receiving a written statement for such confinement and/or medical treatment within one (1) month of receipt of statement from Loving County current available funds.

VIII

Loving County agrees to hold harmless Winkler County from any and all claims against Winkler County, with the specific exception of any claims arising out of the willful or criminal conduct of any county employee, by reason of the housing, restraining, furnishing meals and bed, other support, medical treatment and/or the lack of any thereof and the release of any Loving County prisoner.

IX

This contract shall be for a term of one (1) year ending December 31, 2020 unless cancelled in writing by either party upon sixty (60) days written notice to the other party.
