GENERAL CONDITIONS/INSTRUCTIONS

1. Bids are solicited for furnishing the materials set forth in this invitation to bid. **Deadline:** Completed bid proposals must be received in the **Hamilton County Clerk's Office, 102 North Rice, Suite 107, Hamilton, Texas 76531** by **Friday, July 19, 2024 at 4:00 P.M.** All bids must be in a sealed envelope clearly marked, **SEALED BID-CONCRETE LOW WATER CROSSING.**
2. Bids received in the Hamilton County Clerk's Office after the submission deadline shall be unopened and will be considered void and unacceptable. Hamilton County is not responsible for delayed mail, carrier, etc. and the time/date stamp clock used upon receipt of any bid in the county clerk's office shall be the official time of receipt. **No fax bids or emails will be accepted.**
3. Bids may be withdrawn at any time prior to the official opening. Alterations made before opening time must be initialed by bidder guaranteeing authenticity. After the official opening, bids may not be amended, altered or withdrawn without the recommendation and approval of the Hamilton County Commissioners Court.
4. The County reserves the right to accept or reject in part or in whole any bids submitted and to waive any technicalities related to the bidding process for the benefit of the County, granted that such waiver is allowed under federal and state law.
5. Invoices shall be sent directly to the Hamilton County Assistant Auditor, 102 North Rice, Suite 220, Hamilton, Texas 76531. Payment will be processed after confirmation that all materials have been received satisfactorily and no unauthorized materials have been received.
6. Hamilton County terms of invoice are net thirty (30) days from statement date.
7. The County may extend the contract associated with an accepted bid provided that all terms and conditions of the contract remain unchanged and in full force and effect. Exceptions to this section shall be made for

extensions of the contract period and adjustment of any price cited in the contract. The county's option to renew shall be in writing and shall be signed by both parties prior to the expiration of this contract. The normal extension period shall be in one (1) year increments. The total period of this contract, including all extensions as a result of exercising this option may not exceed a maximum combined period of original contract period plus two (2) years.

8. If this bid is accepted and approved by the Commissioners Court then this bid shall be incorporated into a contract. No oral agreements either expressed or implied shall be valid. No different or additional terms will become part of this contract unless agreed upon by both parties.
9. By accepting this invitation to bid and bidding on the item(s) set forth above you are accepting any and all of the general conditions set forth above and any additional specifications and conditions contained with the contract attached.

SPECIFICATIONS: COUNTY ROAD 402-PCT. 2

Bid for concrete low water crossing repair. Dig out 8 inches of fill and replace with approximately 20 Feet x 18 Feet x 8 inches of slab between two (2) existing ends. This is to be reinforced with #4 rebar on 16-inch center to center and doweled into existing ends and doweled into a 12-inch x 3 foot or to rock footing to be dug inside existing rock wall on each side; also, be reinforced # 4 rebar on 12-inch center to center. Figure extra concrete to lock in the concrete and rock rip rap on bottom side of crossing.
