Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met on, Friday, June 21, 2024 at 9:00 a.m. with the following members present: County Judge James Yates, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Lloyd Huggins, Dickie Clary and Keith Curry. Judge Yates called the meeting to order and a quorum was established. Commissioner Huggins led the invocation and all followed with the pledges.

There were no Open Comments.

There were no Budget Adjustments (L.I.T.).

The Commissioners Court opened the Sealed Bids for the Concrete Low Water Crossing in Precinct 2, Bid # HC2024-02. Commissioner Curry made a motion to award the Bid to Gary Sparks and Commissioner Clary seconded the motion. The Commissioners Court awarded Bid # HC2024-02, Low Water Crossing for Precinct 2 by a 4-0 vote, Judge Yates abstained. Please see the attached spreadsheet for the individual Bids received.

The Commissioners Court recessed at 9:15.

The Commissioners Court reconvened at 10:00 am at the Hamilton Public Library for the Texas Division of Emergency Management Application Briefing on the May flooding 2024 Disaster recovery DR 4781. Recovery Coordinator, Brandy Masterson provided a Power Point presentation outlining the proper procedures and timelines necessary to receive FEMA assistance. During the presentation the attendees were notified that each entity (i.e. – City, County, ISD's, etc.) must file their own RPA submissions before August 9, 2024. TDEM and FEMA will be planning additional meetings in the near future to provide more information. The required RPA Submission meeting adjourned at 11:55 am.

Special Setting of Commissioners court resumed at 11:56 am to discuss the Allocations of the Road and Bridge Funds. \$100,000.00 will be allocated the Precinct #2 to begin the Concrete Low Water Crossing project. \$200,000.00 will be divided by four, allocating \$50,000.00 to each Commissioner precinct. The money will be moved from the Contingency Fund into each of the Precincts Road & Bridge Fund. Commissioner Huggins made a motion and Commissioner Clary seconded the motion. The Commissioners court approved the allocations of the Road and Bridge Funds by a 4-0 vote, Judge Yates abstained.

There was no discussion on the FY 2024-2025 Budget.
