Hamilton County Commissioner's Court met in regular session on Tuesday, June 12, 2018 at 9:00 A.M. with the following members present: County Judge Mark Tynes, Commissioners Johnny Wagner, Keith Allen Curry, Lloyd Huggins and Dickie Clary.

Tynes called the meeting to order and a quorum was established.

Wagner led the invocation and Tynes followed with the pledges.

Richard Layne stood in the public comments and thanked the court for the opportunity to speak. He said that it seemed like the more transparent the court was trying to become the less transparent they were becoming.

There were no line item transfers submitted.

A motion was made by Huggins and seconded by Clary to approve the following consent agenda:

- A. Minutes of the 6-5-2018 commissioner's court meeting
- B. Approval of all departmental reports submitted (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 60 Page 224)
- C. Approve bills submitted for payment in the amount of \$81,896.05 (Recorded in Commissioner's Court Papers Book 60 Page 245)

The motion carried unanimously.

There were no certificates of continuing education submitted. Tynes did state that this agenda item will be placed on the consent agenda in the future.

Huggins told the court that there had been some interest shown in the old precinct 3 barn, but he had not received an offer that he felt appropriate to bring to the court as of yet.

The court took no action on the burn ban.

There were no future agenda items.

At 9:06 A.M. to court went into a budget workshop.

The judge presented the members of the court R3 version of the proposed budget. They spoke of the increase in the DA's budget for the upcoming year with the transition of the Assistant DA to District Judge, a possible 5% increase in health insurance, normal annual operations in each precinct and possible longevity pay options. There was a handout of the options given to the members of the court. County Clerk did not receive a copy of this. No decisions were reached at this time.

Tynes adjourned the court at 10:45 A.M.
