IN THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF

ORDER ADOPTING REDISTRICTING  
FOR JUSTICE OF THE PEACE/CONSTABLE PRECINCTS 1 and 4

BE IT REMEMBERED, that on the 23 day of December, 2025, after due notice as required by law, came on to be considered the issue of consolidation of Hunt County Justice of the Peace/Constable Precincts 1 and 4.

This Court has commissioned and has received the advice of qualified professionals experienced in the field of voting rights law to assist in an assessment of need, services, distribution of caseload and other factors relevant to the question of whether or not to change the political boundaries of Justice of the Peace/Constable Precincts 1 and 4 would be feasible and in the public interest.

It is the determination of this Court, based upon the foregoing, that the needs of the public will be adequately and suitably served by revising the political boundaries of Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 and Justice of the Peace Precinct 4. Additionally, the Commissioners Court is satisfied that by realigning Precincts 1 and 4 will have no significant adverse impact upon minority voting rights, or of the public services rendered to the residents of Hunt County.

Therefore, meeting in open session for the purpose of considering the same, the Commissioners Court of Hunt County, Texas, has determined to adopt this Order, along with the map attached to this Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED ADJUDGED AND DECREED, that the territorial boundaries Justice of the Peace/Constable Precinct 1 and Justice of the Peace/Constable Precinct 4 are revised.



This Order shall not impair the remaining term of office of any Justice of the Peace or Constable serving in office at the time of the passage of this Order or elected at the November 5, 2024 general election. This Order shall be effective January 1, 2026.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that this Order revising the political boundaries of Justice of the Peace Precinct 1 and Justice of the Peace Precinct 4 depicted in the maps attached to this Order are hereby APPROVED and ADOPTED by the Commissioners Court of Hunt County, Texas. This Order is made for the convenience and benefit of the people of Hunt County, Texas after due and careful consideration of all factors relevant to the issue.


