ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER REGARDING ESTATES CODE §1101.003 AFFIDAVIT CONTAINING CONTACT INFORMATION OF CERTAIN PERSONS

The Colorado County Court finds that there is a need for an administrative order regarding Texas Estates Code §1101.003.

The Court finds as follows:

- 1. §1101.003(a) of the Texas Estates Code requires that:
 Within the time prescribed by the court, a person who files an application under Section 1101.001 shall file an affidavit with the court that states the name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, and other contact information if known by the applicant for each person entitled to notice under Section 1051.104(a).
- 2. §1101.003(b) of the Texas Estates Code provides that:
 An affidavit filed under this section is privileged and confidential. The affidavit may not be released or otherwise disclosed to the public.

It is therefore ORDERED that, effective immediately, when a person files an application for the appointment of a guardian pursuant to §1101.001:

- 1. The applicant shall file with the Court the affidavit containing contact information of certain persons pursuant to §1101.003 at least <u>5</u> days prior to prove-up, trial or other final disposition. The affidavit shall be captioned "§1101.003 Affidavit Containing Contact Information of Certain Persons."
- 2. The Colorado County Clerk's Office shall seal the affidavit and not release or otherwise disclose the affidavit, or the information contained therein to the public.
