Re: Public Access to the Initially Prepared 2021 Brazos G Regional Water Plan

Dear Jodi Morgan,

The Brazos G Regional Water Planning Group is preparing for a public hearing on the Initially Prepared Brazos G 2026 Regional Water Plan (IPP). The IPP will be completed in early March 2025. The public hearing is planned for May 6, 2025. Prior to the public hearing, the IPP must be accessible to the public in accordance with Texas Administrative Code 357.21(h)7.

RWPGs shall make copies of the IPP available for public inspection at least 30 days before the required public hearing by providing a copy of the IPP in at least one public library in each county and either the county courthouse's law library, the county clerk's office, or some other accessible place within the county courthouse of each county having land in the RWPA. The locations of such copies shall be included in the public hearing... According to the capabilities of the facility, the RWPG may provide the copy electronically, on electronic media, through an internet web link, or in hard copy. The RWPG shall make an effort to ensure ease of access to the public, including where feasible, posting the IPP on websites and providing notice of such posting.

Will you please advise me your desired method of providing public access to the IPP to best serve your county (hard copy, electronic media, or web link)? According to discussions with the Texas Water Development Board, if electronic media or a web link is provided, the local facility must have the capability for the public to access the document on-site (in the Clerk's office, courthouse law library or other courthouse location).

Additionally, would you please recommend a public library in your county with public computer access where I can provide a notice of the public hearing with a link to the IPP on the Brazos G website? It will be very helpful if you can provide this information via email at <a href="mailto:pamela.hannemann@brazos.org">pamela.hannemann@brazos.org</a> by March 5, 2025.
