

Public Hearing to Consider Amending Rules

The Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District (“POSGCD” or “District”) will hold a public hearing on September 10, 2024, on the amendment of the Rules of the Post Oak Savannah Groundwater Conservation District (“Rules”).

The Board of Directors will consider amending the Rules at the Board Meeting following the public hearing. The amendments include but are not limited to Section 1.1 Definitions of Terms, Section 4.1 Required Spacing, Section 4.2 Exceptions to Spacing Requirements, Section 5.1 Maximum Allowable Permitted Production, Section 5.3 Waivers and Variances, Section 5.5 Regulation of Production For Local Water Utilities, Section 7.1 General Permit and Registration Provisions, Section 7.4 Application Requirement For All Permits, Section 7.6 Considerations For Granting Permits, Section 7.10 Exempt Well Status, Section 16.5 Five (5) Year Reviews and Section 18 Requests For Verification of Water Availability Studies For Subdivisions.

The public hearing and board meeting will be conducted at the District’s office located at 310 East Avenue C in Milano Texas.

All interested persons are invited to attend and provide public comment. The District Offices will be open to the Directors, Staff, Consultants and public who wish to attend in person, while others may attend virtually.
