<u>Summary:</u> The responsibilities of this position include developing and implementing the Community and Clinical Health Bridge (CCHB) Project. The goal of the CCHB project is to reduce the impact that obesity and related chronic disease has on residents. This is accomplished by establishing collaborative relationships with traditional and non-traditional contacts, direct health education, community outreach, and utilizing tools to track and report program effectiveness.
