ORDINANCE #3-2024 LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE LEVY OF AD VALOREM TAXES ON ALL REAL PROPERTY AND PERSONAL PROPERTY SITUATED WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF COMANCHE, TEXAS, FOR THE YEAR 2024. DISTRIBUTING THE SAME AMONG THE VARIOUS FUNDS; PROVIDING FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST FOR FAILURE TO PAY THE TAXES LEVIED WITHIN THE TIME PROVIDED BY LAW; FIXING A LIEN ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY TO SECURE THE PAYMENT OF TAXES; AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES FOR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COMANCHE, TEXAS:

Section 1. That there be and there is hereby levied and there shall be collected an ad valorem tax of \$0.586746 on each One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) dollars assessed valuation on all real and personal property situated within the corporate limits of the City of Comanche on the first day of January A.D., 2024, and not exempt from taxation by the constitution and laws of the State of Texas, apportioned as follows, to wit:

FOR GENERAL FUND EXPENDITURES: \$0.476680 ON EACH One Hundred and No/100 (\$100.00) dollars assessed valuation of such property;

FOR DEBT SERVICES FUND OBLIGATIONS: \$0.110066 on each One Hundred and No/100 (\$100) dollars assessed valuation of such property.

This year's levy to fund maintenance and operations expenditures exceeds last year's maintenance and operations tax levy. Also, this year's M&O tax rate is higher than the no new-revenue maintenance and operations tax rate.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 3.5% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$-38.12.

Section 2: That all taxes shall be payable upon receipt of the Tax Statement. If such taxes are not paid in full on or before January 31, 2025, penalty and interest of seven percent (7%) shall be charged and collected; for taxes not paid prior to March 1, 2025, nine percent (9%) shall be charged and collected; for taxes not paid prior to April 1, 2025, eleven percent (11% shall be charged and collected; for taxes not paid prior to May 1, 2025, thirteen percent (13%) shall be charged and collected; for taxes not paid prior to June 1, 2025, fifteen percent (15%) shall be charged and collected; for taxes not paid prior to July 1, 2025, eighteen percent (18% shall be charged and collected; for taxes not paid prior to August 1, 2025, and additional one percent (1%) shall be charged and collected for taxes not paid for each additional month until same has

I, Mayor Pro Tem Esmeralda Cumba move that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.586746 which is effectively a 3.50 percent increase in the rate.

This tax rate will raise more taxes for maintenance and operations than last year's tax rate. The tax rate will effectively be raised by 3.50% and will raise taxes for maintenance and operations on a \$100,000 home by approximately \$ -38.12.

ORDINANCE # 008-24

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS, LEVYING THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY, NOT EXEMPT BY LAW, FOR THE 2024 TAX YEAR; PROVIDING WHEN TAXES SHALL BECOME DUE AND WHEN SAME SHALL BECOME DELINQUENT IF NOT PAID.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1:

That under the authority of the Charter of the City of De Leon, and the laws of the State of Texas, there is hereby levied for the 2024 tax year, on all taxable property situated within the corporate limits of the City of De Leon, and not exempt by the Constitution and Laws of the State of Texas, a total tax of \$0.401828 for each \$100.00 valuation of property.

SECTION 2:

(a) That of the total tax, \$0.401828 on each \$100 assessed value, shall be distributed to the General Fund of the City to fund maintenance and operation expenditures of the City.

This year's levy to fund maintenance and operations expenditures exceeds last year's maintenance and operations tax levy.

THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.
THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 7.31 PERCENT AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS ON A \$100,000 HOME BY APPROXIMATELY \$-3.63.

(b) The City Secretary shall cause the following notice to be posted on the homepage of the City's internet website:

THE CITY OF DE LEON, TEXAS ADOPTED A TAX RATE THAT WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE.

SECTION 3:

That taxes levied under this ordinance shall be due October 1, 2024, and if not paid on or before January 31, 2025, shall immediately become delinquent.

SECTION 4:

All taxes shall become a lien upon the property against which assessed, and the tax collector of the City of De Leon, is hereby authorized and empowered to enforce the collection of such taxes according to the constitution and laws of the State of Texas and Charter and Ordinances of the City of De Leon, shall, by virtue of the tax rolls, fix and establish a lien by levying upon such property, whether real or personal, for the payment of said taxes, penalty and interest, and the penalty and interest collected from such delinquent taxes shall be apportioned to the General Fund of the City of De Leon. All delinquent taxes shall bear interest from date of delinquency at the rate prescribed by state law.

SECTION 5:

This Ordinance shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its final passage and publication as herein provided.

SECTION 6:

That it is hereby officially found and determined that the meeting at which this ordinance is passed was open to the public as required and that public notice of the time, place and purpose of said meeting was given as required by the *Open Meeting Act, Chapter 551, Loc. Gov't. Code.*

SECTION 7:
