## JIM HOGG COUNTY IS SOLICITING SEALED BIDS FOR TAX OFFICE IMPROVEMENTS

JIM HOGG COUNTY is accepting SEALED BIDS for TAX OFFICE IMPROVEMENTS (ROOF REPAIRS) until 2:00 p.m., Monday May 22, 2023. Bids will be opened at the Commissioner's Court Meeting of May 24, 2023. Any proposal received after the due date shall be returned unopened. Bids submitted via faxes or electronic media will not be accepted.

Specific improvements for Jim Hogg County Tax office building are the following: remove and replace asphalt shingles with 30-year dimensional asphalt shingles, remove and replace rotten/ damaged plywood, remove and replace rotten face boards, remove and replace all vent pipe roof flashing, and add face boards to existing areas that don't have face boards.

**Painting:** prime all new face boards, scrape and wash existing face boards, soffit to prepare surfaces to be primed and painted, color of paint will be determined by County Judge. Specifications are available and can be obtained at the courthouse located at 102 E. Tilley, Hebbronville, TX 78361 or can be requested from Alfredo Alaniz at 361-231-5106.

The bids shall be addressed to: Juan Carlos Guerra, County Judge, 102 E. Tilley, Hebbronville, TX 78361, and clearly marked: "SEALED BID – TAX OFFICE IMPROVEMENTS" on the lower left-hand corner.

Jim Hogg County reserves the right to postpone, to accept or to reject any and all bids, or to waive any informalities in the process. Bids may be held by Jim Hogg County for a period not to exceed thirty (30) days from the date of the bid opening for the purpose of reviewing the bids and investigation of the respondents' qualifications and making recommendations to the Commissioner's Court for contract award.
