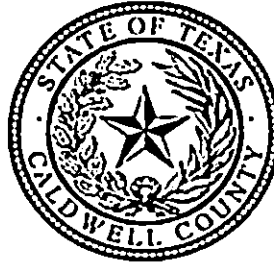

The Court reserves the right to take any and all appropriate actions regarding the redistricting of Caldwell County political boundaries, including the acceptance of new boundaries for the Commissioners Court precincts, modification of any boundaries, and/or tabling the pending proposals for later consideration and/or action.
