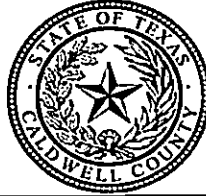

Barbara Gonzales, County Auditor asks that Elected officials and department heads review their budgets.

Ezzy Chan, Executive Assistant reports that with extra pay period this year a line item will be added for the adjustment.

Judge Haden reviews the American Rescue Fund and proposals on allocating funds, any other suggestions should have estimates to be reviewed by Dennis Engelke, and brought to the next workshop. Reports the Texas Legislature is in special session with Health and Human Service Committee on distribution of funds. Judge Haden will be attending a meeting with LCRA Colorado River Basin on Thursday and Friday.

Judge Haden requests a motion to skip invocation and pledge. So moved by Commissioner Theriot, seconded by Commissioner Shelton. All voting "Aye".

Judge Haden reports the City of Luling has 22 acres north of Luling/south of Lockhart on Hwy 183 for the Emergency Center project. City of Luling is waiting on City council approval.
