Clerk Russell read the minutes from the September 8<sup>th</sup>, 2025 regular meeting of Commissioners Court. Judge Meador asked for a motion to accept the minutes as read. Motion by Commissioner Campbell to accept the minutes as read, it was seconded by Commissioner Brooks and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

County Judge Meador gave the monthly reports from County and District Clerk, Justice of the Peace, County Agent, Tax Assessor Collector, Library, and the Sheriff's Office. Motion by Commissioner Jameson and seconded by Commissioner Cruse to accept the reports as given. Motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

The bills were presented by Treasurer Jones. The bills were reviewed by the court. Motion by Commissioner Campbell to pay the bills presented, motion was seconded by Commissioner Brooks and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Item 8: Marisue Potts presented a proposal for the Motley County Veterans Memorial to be located at the Motley County County Courthouse. (attached to the minutes for reference)

Item 9: Approve the Resolution for Indigent Defense Grant. A motion was made by Commissioner Campbell to approve the Grant, seconded by Commissioner Cruse and the motion carried with a 5 to 0 vote.

Item 10: Approve the revision to the Motley County Policy Handbook. Revised/updated to include the retirement and term life. Motion by Commissioner Cruse and Seconded by Commissioner Campbell to approve the revision. Motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Item 11: Consider a New Patrol Vehicle for the Sheriff's Department. Sheriff stated that he would like to purchase a new pickup and equipment to outfit it with as the oldest vehicle a lot of the equipment just can't be updated anymore. Motion by Commissioner Campbell for the Sheriff's department to purchase a new pickup using SB-22 money. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Brooks and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote. And a motion by Commissioner Jameson for the Sheriff's Department to purchase equipment with SB-22 money to outfit the pickup, motion was seconded by Commissioner Brooks and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Item 12: Consider changing the MTD license for the Sheriff Department for the office and patrol vehicles. The new service will also cover the J.P.'s office and when they are out patrolling an write a ticket it will automatically send to the J.P's office. Motion by Commissioner Jameson to upgrade the software for the sheriff's department using SB-22 money. Motion was seconded by Commissioner Brooks and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Item 13: Consider subscription for the Peace Maker MTD computers for the Sheriff Department. Motion by Commissioner Cruse for the sheriff's department to purchase new computers from PeaceMaker MTD with SB-22 money, seconded by Commissioner Lameson and the motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.

Item 14: Consider Opiod Fund request for the Sheriff Department. Sheriff Fisk stated he would like to use the Opiod Settlement Fund for education in his department. \$900.00 per officer for training/school. Motion by Commissioner Brooks and seconded by Commissioner Jameson for the Sheriff depart to use the Settlement money for education/training. Motion passed with a 5 to 0 vote.
