

PROPOSALS FOR A MOTLEY COUNTY VETERANS MEMORIAL
LOCATED ON THE COURTHOUSE SQUARE

1. Establish criteria:
 - a. Veterans born in Motley County
 - b. Veterans who lived in Motley County
 - c. Veterans who attended school in Motley County
 - d. Veterans who are buried in Motley County
2. Receive approval from County Commissioners Court
 - a. Establish an account to accept donations
 - b. Contact Newspapers, Facebook, Motley County Ex-students
 - c. Contact Veterans Organizations
 - d. Search for and apply for grants
3. Develop a plan for county memorial to be completed in stages:
 - a. Medals of Honor, Distinguished Service Medals, Recognition
 - b. Those who gave their lives for our country listed by wars
 - c. Purple Heart Medals (Wounded in Action)
 - d. POW list
 - e. Women in Service
 - f. All Motley County Vets listed by wars, additions room for recent wars
4. Prepare the location as money is raised
 - a. Concrete base to include room for first and future granite panels
 - b. Add panels as money is raised for granite and engraving
 - c. Consider sidewalks, benches, and enhancements
 - d. Consider informative markers about individuals:

Frank Mitchell, Travis McDonald, Paul Eubank, W.B. Gilbert, etc.

**2026 Motley County Resolution
Indigent Defense Grant Program**

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Texas Government Code Section 79.037 and Texas Administrative Code Chapter 173, counties are eligible to receive grants from the Texas Indigent Defense Commission to provide improvements in indigent defense services in the county; and

WHEREAS, this grant program will assist the county in the implementation and the improvement of the indigent criminal defense services in this county; and

WHEREAS, Motley County Commissioners Court has agreed that in the event of loss or misuse of the funds, Motley County Commissioners assures that the funds will be returned in full to the Texas Indigent Defense Commission.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED and ordered that the County Judge of this county is designated as the Authorized Official to apply for, accept, decline, modify, or cancel the grant application for the Indigent Defense Formula Grant Program and all other necessary documents to accept said grant; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Treasurer is designated as the Financial Officer for this grant.
