1. County Judge Doug Page called the meeting to order at 9:00 A.M. and noted that the agenda was properly filed and posted at 9:50 A.M., November 19, 2021. All Commissioners were present, other officials' present included, County Auditor Bonnie Kennedy, County Attorney Colton Hay, Treasurer Bob Dockens, JP4 Richard Steptoe, Sheriff Woody Wallace, and County Clerk Shasta Bergman, Judge Page welcomed everyone to the meeting.

Approval of the Reports for the Month of October 2021 of the Justices of the Peace, County Extension Agent, Constables, County Clerk, District Clerk, County Attorney, Sheriff, Tax Assessor, Community Center, and 9-1-1 Addressing made by a motion from Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Truss. Motion carried.
14. Approval of Resolution and Grant Request for FY2022 Criminal Justice Division Body Worn Camera Grant Program was made by a motion from Commissioner Smith and seconded by Commissioner Park. Motion carried.

Discussion and possible action on Forty-Third Emergency Order Regarding the COVID-19 State of Disaster Implemented by Governor Abbott's Office as it relates to safety of Courts in Trinity County, more specifically the wearing of masks which causes a safety concern as people's faces are not completely visible. No action taken at this time.
