Frank Tambunga, Pct. 1 announced agenda to this called session was posted. All agreed and meeting carried on due to proof of posting.


FRONITER CONTRACT FOR FIBER OPTIC SERVICE FOR JAIL "EXHIBIT A"

Antonio Alejandro, Sheriff addressed the Court about this contract. Sheriff Alejandro visited with Jody Upham, County Attorney and she stated that the County never signs five-year contracts unless it is agreed upon through the Court. The internet will still be needed for downloading video cameras and for the jail. This new fiber optic should help with the telephones as well. The five-year contract would cost \$790.00 and one-year contract would cost \$2,650.00. Wesley Bean made a motion to sign contract for fiber optic services for jail for \$790.00. G L Bunker seconded, all in favor. Motion carried.
