**PRESS RELEASE, FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE:
ALARMING RISE OF COVID-19 CASES IN PRESIDIO COUNTY**

WITH CORONA VIRUS ON THE RISE, BIG GATHERINGS SHOULD BE AVOIDED. STATE CORONAVIRUS RULES LIMIT OUTDOOR GATHERINGS TO 100 PEOPLE AND MANDATE MASKS WHERE IT IS HARD TO MAINTAIN DISTANCE FROM OTHERS. THIS REITERATES THE NEED FOR PERSONAL RESPONSIBILITY. YOU MUST PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS- AVOID LARGE GATHERINGS, WEAR A MASK, AND STAY AT LEAST 6 FEET APART FROM OTHER PEOPLE AND FREQUENTLY WASH YOUR HANDS.

On November 19th, 2020, The Texas Department of Health Region 9/10 of El Paso sent a PSAP (Public Service Answering Points) Report, which reported 54 new cases in our county, with 30 in Presidio, 21 in Marfa, 2 in Redford and 1 in Shafter. This information has since been revised by the Texas Department of Health. The corrected amount of new cases are 42 cases of which 29 in Presidio, 10 in Marfa, 2 in Redford and 1 in Shafter.

The Texas Department of Health has informed the County Judge's office of 41 new cases in Presidio County:

Deadly Conduct is a crime defined in the Texas Penal Code under Chapter 22.05. This crime is committed when one recklessly engages in conduct that places another person in imminent danger of serious bodily injury.

PLEASE TAKE THIS VIRUS SERIOUSLY, PROTECT YOURSELF AND OTHERS, WEAR A MASK, WASH YOUR HANDS AND KEEP 6FT DISTANCE
