## Zapata County Businesses Allowed to Operate at 50% Capacity

Zapata County given Texas Department of State Health Services approval to allow greater capacity

ZAPATA, TEXAS—On Thursday May 14, 2020 the Texas Department of State Health Services approved Zapata County as one of the 107 counties in the State of Texas that may allow businesses to operate at 50% capacity.

On Monday, Zapata County Judge Joe Rathmell announced to Commissioners Court that because Zapata County is no longer reporting active COVID-19 cases, he would be requesting approval to allow businesses to operate at 50% capacity if they choose to do so. This is in accordance with Texas Governor Greg Abbott's Executive order to *Open Texas* which states: "Texas counties that have filed with DSHS, and are in compliance with, the requisite attestation form promulgated by DSHS regarding five or fewer cases of COVID-19, those in-store retail services, dine-in restaurant services, movie theaters, shopping malls, museums and libraries, indoor wedding venues, wedding reception services, swimming pools, services provided by office workers in offices of more than five individuals, manufacturing services, and gyms and exercise facilities and classes, as otherwise defined and limited above, may operate at up to 50 percent (as opposed to 25 percent)." The two images below indicate Zapata County's COVID-19 active cases over two months and the counties approved to operate at 50% capacity.
