

The Commissioner’s Court of McCulloch County met in Regular Session on the 27TH day of April 2026 at 9:00 a.m. with the following present:

MINUTES:

BILLS:

Bills for April 27, 2026, were presented and approved. Commissioner Deans made the motion and Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 4-0

Elected Officials/Department Heads: Sheriff Matt Andrews reported to the Court that the jail experienced a leak on Friday that was temporarily patched. However, on Saturday, the line completely burst open, causing electrical damage. Sheriff Andrews stated that emergency lighting is operational and functioning in all cells.

County Treasurer Mikkie Williams distributed budget worksheets to elected officials and advised that the first budget workshop will be scheduled sometime in May.

Commissioner Anderson reported that she spoke with Kendall County Commissioners and invited them to visit McCulloch County to discuss their Road Supervision System. Commissioner Anderson also inquired about the TxDOT project and whether the County may be able to acquire concrete from the project. She further reported that she attended a training session that provided information on how to testify during Senate hearings, which she believes could be very beneficial. County Treasurer Mikkie Williams agreed with Commissioner Anderson regarding the usefulness of the training information.

Commissioner Anderson also reported receiving a request from Oncor for a culvert installation on County Road 138. She addressed the importance of implementing a Road Use Agreement in the near future. Additionally, Commissioner Anderson reported that Wolfe Towing removed an old Precinct 3 truck from her barn and transported it to the 190 yard. Commissioner Maricle reported that he attended a conference where he received valuable information regarding tax abatements, data centers, and Battery Energy Storage Systems (BESS). County Judge Frank Trull reported that the County received five submissions in response to the Request for Qualifications pertaining to the Outdoor Warning Sirens SB3 Grant project. Judge Trull advised that the packets had been forwarded to each Commissioner and requested that they complete their evaluations and scoring in a timely manner due to the narrow timeline for the project.

Judge Trull also informed the Court that John Boyd with Boyds of Texas is scheduled to visit on Wednesday to conduct a preliminary review of the courthouse roof and gutter system and determine the repairs needed. He further reported that Boyds of Texas is currently in the process of becoming a BuyBoard vendor.

Judge Trull additionally reported that wiring on the courthouse chillers had been damaged by squirrels. Duncan Mechanical is currently working on repairs to the chillers. He also stated that the boilers, along with an actuator affecting the County Treasurer’s Office and District Clerk’s Office, have experienced operational issues or are not functioning properly. Repair parts for both pieces of equipment have been ordered.

DISCUSSION:

ACTION:

1. The Court acted and approved a Proclamation declaring April 26, 2026 through May 3, 2026 as soil and Water Stewardship week. Food connection day by Texas Farm Bureau will be held on May 6, 2026 at the local Tractor Supply Company. Commissioner Maricle made the motion to

approve the Proclamation with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 4-0.

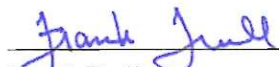
2. The Court acted and approved CTTC to place a buried fiber optic internet cable on County Road 356 between CR 330 and CR 340. There is a customer that has applied for phone service on the side of CR 356. Commissioner Anderson stated she had spoken to Commissioner Young and he did not have a problem with this request. Commissioner Deans made the motion and Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 4-0.
3. The Court acted and approved CTTC request to extend a route of cable on CR 300 North of FM 765. Commissioner Deans made the motion to approve the extension with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 4-0
4. The Court considered and approved the donations, memorials, and reporting on monies received to the McCulloch County Library from February 1 to February 28, 2026. Commissioner Maricle made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 4-0
5. The Court acted and approved the donations, memorials, and reporting on monies received to the McCulloch County Library from March 1 to March 31, 2026. Commissioner Maricle made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 4-0
6. The Court acted and approved CTTC a request to the Texas comptroller of Public Accounts to claim Unclaimed Property Capital Credits. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Maricle seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 4-0
7. The Court approved on a closed executive session pursuant to Texas Government Code Chapter 551 Section 551.071 consultation with County Attorney Greg Torres in regards to Wind Energy Tax Abatement compliance. Commissioner Deans made the motion to go into Closed Executive session at 9:57 AM with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in Favor Motion Carries. 4-0

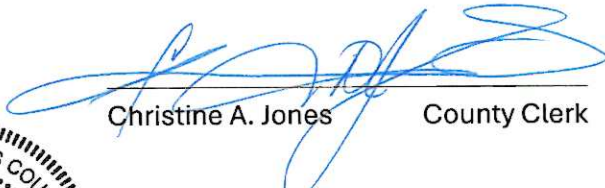
CLOSED SESSION AT 9:57 AM, took a short break, began closed session at 10:02 AM
