Bills for November 09, 2020 were presented and approved with Commissioner Deans making the motion and Commissioner Kemp seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 3-0

Reports from Department heads were heard. Sheriff John Dagen reported there were 6 active cases of COVID in the jail. Precautions have been and are taken place every day.

Discussion:


Action:
