**DISCUSSION:**

**ACTION:**

1. The McCulloch County Commissioners met to consider and act of approving an Interlocal Agreement between City of Brady and McCulloch County for Emergency Services. They expressed several concerns with the local agreement that was drawn up and presented to the court by the City of Brady. The City would like a response by September 30, 2022 with what the County would like to do with accepting the agreement as it is written or to explore other options. Mrs. Corbell with the City expressed in the letter that the City of Brady Council is set with what they are offering. The Court expressed several concerns of the amounts of fees to the county residents outside of the city limits. It was also stated that the current Agreement went into effect automatically on September 1, 2022 and the new agreement could not be terminated by either party without following procedures stated in the current agreement. The court again expressed the need for an open meeting with the City of Brady or explore going through a third-party mediator to help resolve the issues between both parties. Commissioner Anderson motioned to take no Action on new agreement for the fact being we are bound by the automatically renewed agreement as of September 1, 2022. County Judge Frank Trull seconded. All in favor Motion carries. NO ACTION.
