

The Commissioner’s Court of McCulloch County met in Regular Session on the 10TH day of July, 2023 at 9:00 a.m. with the following present:

Invocation was given by Commissioner Behrens followed by the Pledge to the U.S. and Texas Flags.

Public Comment:

Bills for July 10, 2023 were presented and approved with Commissioner Behrens making the motion and Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0

Elected Officials/Department Heads: County Sheriff Matt Andrews introduce new Deputy Nicholas Escobar to the Court and Public, he has been working for the Sheriff’s Department for a few weeks and doing very well. Sheriff Andrews reported that they are now at full staff for Deputies.

Discussion:

1. Discussion on the letter dated July 6, 2023 from the Brady City Manager Erin Corbell in regards to payment for EMS services was held. The court agreed that wrong and mis information had been put out and wanted to clarify that the County never voted to a monthly payment plan with the City. The Court is very pleased that a meeting being held on the 17th of July with the City Council and that they will be able to get things moving for next year.

Action:

1. The Court acted and approved the payment of \$8,588.88 to the City of Brady for EMS services. With this payment and previously approved payments, the City of Brady will receive a total of \$207,000.00 for EMS services provided to McCulloch County from October 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
2. The Court discussed, acted, and approved a budget amendment in the amount of \$17,000.00 from excess interest revenue to 0010.0403.4420 for the payment of the remaining balance for EMS services to the City of Brady. Commissioner Deans made the motion and Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
3. The Court discussed, acted, and approved a request for proposal of bank depository contract to be posted continuously for 20 days per local Government Code 116. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Anderson seconded. All in favor Motion carried. 5-0
4. The Court discussed, acted, and approved the reallocation of CSLFRF funds due to the approval of \$45,346.26 CSLFRF funds for the Rochelle Volunteer Fire Department. The Court reallocated \$23,346.26 from the renovate/paint of the courthouse window and repair settling issues, \$10,000.00 from the remodel of the old Jail for storage purposes project, \$10,000.00 from Dump Truck , and \$2,000.00 from Wheel Loader purchases for a total of \$45,346.26. Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Bratton seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0.
5. The Court discussed, acted, and approved an interlocal agreement between the Regional Public Defender Office Local Government Corporation and McCulloch County to provide court appointed counsel for indigent individuals charged with the offense of capital murder. Commissioner Behrens made the motion with Commissioner Deans seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0

Recess at 9:42 AM Commissioner Deans made the motion with Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0


Reconvened at 10:30 AM with Commissioner Deans making the motion and Commissioner Behrens seconded. All in favor Motion carries. 5-0
